- 2. The need for infrastructure to be extended to undeveloped areas, "landlocked" issues, development to the west.
- 3. Review the ideas of natural gas, internet connectivity, and helping existing businesses/property owners before bringing in new.
- 4. Encourage the City to identify the community assets. Invite business owners and city members to brainstorm. School system, parks, events, housing, closeness to FM, etc.
- 5. Downtown should be pleasant, inviting, and create a good experience. Livability, walkability, and uniqueness can create experience that encourage people to visit.
- 6. Continue moving past the small-town mentality. Attend GFMEDC meetings for more info or to reach out for help.
